Police said they arrested a man with 16 bags of heroin on him in the township's DDACTS zone.

EVESHAM — Township police said they recovered 16 bags of heroin after pulling over a township man for careless driving on Jan. 26.

Cinque Hynson, 27, was charged with possession of heroin and a disorderly persons offenses for possession of drug paraphernalia after he was pulled over in the township's DDACTS Zone, police said.

Hynson was a "wanted person" by the Burlington County Prosecutor's Office for an undetermined crime, police said. He was taken to Burlington County Jail.

The goal of Data Drive Approach to Crime and Traffic Safety is to reduce crime, accidents and violations. Police use the program by deploying law enforcement resources to areas with higher rates of crime and crashes, which for the township is a 2.2-mile stretch along Routes 73 and 70.
