# News Release

Incident: Motor Vehicle Stop/CDS Arrest

On Friday, March 1st, 2019 at approximately 1:15 p.m., Egg Harbor Township Police Officer Ben Kollman conducted a motor vehicle stop for multiple motor vehicle violations on Tilton Road in the area of Boardwalk Honda, in the Cardiff section of the Township. The driver was identified as Samuel Jean, 36 years of age from Mays Landing.

A subsequent investigation was conducted and led to the recovery of 5.3 Ounces of Cocaine and 2 grams of raw Marijuana. Jean was arrested and charged with the following:

- Possession of CDS Cocaine
- Possession of Marijuana Under 50 Grams
- Distribution of CDS Heroin/Cocaine
- Failure to Surrender CDS to Law Enforcement
- Title 39 (Traffic) Offenses

As part of the investigation, Jean's vehicle and \$920.00 in cash was seized. Jean was lodged in the Atlantic County Justice Facility on a warrant.

It should be noted that the motor vehicle was stopped during a directed patrol for DDACTS. The acronym stands for Data Driven Approach to Crime and Traffic Safety. One of the key elements of the DDACTS model is the nexus between the strategy and tactics of traffic enforcement and the prevention of non-traffic crime. In other words, "The application of high-visibility traffic enforcement is a proven and effective countermeasure that addresses both crime and crashes whether they occur simultaneously or independently in time and/or location" (Bureau of Justice Assistance, 2009).
