

**RESOLUTION 20190903-011**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ANGLETON, TEXAS DECLARING THAT THE CITY IS DEDICATED TO REDUCING CRIME, CRASHES, AND TRAFFIC VIOLATIONS AND CALLS UPON THE CITIZENS TO ASSIST IN THESE EFFORTS; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS**, no community or family is untouched by incidents of crime or the fear of being victimized by crime; and

**WHEREAS**, traffic crashes are a leading cause of death in the United States; and

**WHEREAS**, Data-Driven Approaches to Crime and Traffic Safety (DDACTS) is a law enforcement operational model supported by partnerships among the Department of Transportation's National Highway Traffic Safety Administration and two agencies of the Department of Justice: the Bureau of Justice Assistance and the National Institute of Justice; and

**WHEREAS**, the model responds to the competing demands for police services that law enforcement executives face every day; and

**WHEREAS**, drawing on the deterrent value of highly visible traffic enforcement and the knowledge that crimes often involve motor vehicles, the goal of DDACTS is to reduce crime, crashes, and traffic violations; and

**WHEREAS**, community partnerships are essential to establish support for targeted traffic enforcement strategies that play a dual role in fighting crime and reducing crashes and traffic violations;

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ANGLETON, TEXAS:**


**SECTION 1.** The City Council of the City of Angleton hereby dedicates itself to improving quality of life by reducing crime, crashes, and traffic violations, and calls upon its citizens to assist in these efforts.

**SECTION 2.** The meeting at which this Resolution was approved was a regular meeting of the City Council, and in all things, was conducted in strict compliance with the Texas Open Meetings Act, Texas Government Code, Chapter 551.


**SECTION 3.** This Resolution shall become effective upon its passage.
