EVENT OBJECTIVES (ICS 202)

1. Event Name: DDACTS WEST	2. Operational Period: Date From: 05/7/14 Time From: 1600 hrs	Date To: 05/29/14 Time To: 0100 hrs
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3. Objective(s):

- Protect life and property.
- Show a high-visibility uniformed presence in the targeted area.
- Provide maximum enforcement in a targeted area by fairly and impartially enforcing the California Penal Code, California Vehicle Code, Long Beach Municipal Code, and all other applicable laws.

4. Operational Period Command Emphasis:
 The Long Beach Police Department (LBPD) will be combining enforcement efforts with area stakeholder agencies to establish a high visibility uniformed presence in data-based selected areas. Motorcycle and vehicle patrols will commence in targeted areas, in an effort to abate traffic collisions and select Part 1 crimes.

General Situational Awareness (Background and Intelligence Information):

Data-Driven Approach to Crime & Traffic Safety (DDACTS) is a law enforcement operational model that integrates location-based crime and traffic crash data to determine the most effective methods for deploying law enforcement and other resources. Drawing on the deterrent value of highly visible traffic enforcement and the knowledge that crimes often involve motor vehicles, the goal of DDACTS is to reduce crime, crashes, and traffic violations in specific areas. Using geo-mapping to identify "hot spots" – areas of high incidence of crimes and crashes– DDACTS uses targeted traffic enforcement strategies that play two roles in fighting crime and reducing crashes and traffic violations. The model responds to the competing demands for police services that law enforcement executives face every day.

DDACTS Operational Guidelines has seven key guiding principles: Partnership & Stakeholder Participation, Data Collection, Data Analysis, Strategic Operations, Information Sharing and Outreach, Monitoring, Evaluation and Adjustments, and Outcomes. Based upon major Part 1 crime and collision data, the area of focused enforcement selected for the operation is 20th Street south to 12th St. and Magnolia Av. east to Atlantic Av. The operation will run Wednesdays and Thursdays from May 7, 2014 through May 29, 2014, excluding the days prior to Memorial Day weekend (May 21 - 22). The Long Beach Police Department will be pooling resources and personnel into the target area with stakeholder agencies: California Highway Patrol (CHP), Signal Hill Police Department (SHPD), and Los Angeles County Sheriff's Department (LASD).
