CALLAWAY COUNTY, Mo. - A man could face drug charges after the Missouri State Highway Patrol arrested him Friday morning in Callaway County.

Last night, a traffic stop for following too close on I-70 in Callaway Co. resulted in seizure of Oxycodone, THC wax, shatter & over \$26,000 in cash.

Troopers said more than 11 ounces of marijuana, THC wax, THC shatter, nearly 40 pills of Oxycodone and around \$26,000 in cash was found.

Roberts was arrested on possible charges of delivery of a controlled substance, possession of a controlled substance and unlawful possession of drug paraphernalia.

At last check, prosecutors haven't filed formal charges against Roberts.
