David Westlake was introduced to law enforcement as a Cadet for the Inglewood City Police Department in 1994. David collected evidence, wrote reports and directed traffic. In 1996, he was hired as a sworn deputy for the Los Angeles County Sheriff's Office. He worked in the jail system from 1996 until early 2000. During that time, he was a new employee trainer, watch deputy, facility control deputy and scheduling deputy. David worked patrol at San Dimas and Lakewood stations from 2000 until December 2004. During which time, he was selected to be the Crime Prevention Deputy where, in addition to patrol duties, he developed curriculum and taught citizens about internet safety, forgery/fraud prevention, and home safety.

In December 2004, David became employed with the Spokane County Sheriff's Office. He has worked patrol and became an FTO in 2013. David instructs numerous subjects for the department including mobile CAD, radio, RBT, report writing and computer use. He is a NAFTO regional director for Northeast Washington state. He instructs in the FTO academy throughout the state, including students from North Idaho. In June 2018, David became the Mobile IT Systems Manager maintaining the fleet of patrol laptops, their programs and mobile CAD system.
