Justin Wykes is a High-Tech Crime Specialist with the National White Collar Crime Center (NW3C) responsible for the development and maintenance of the Advanced Digital Forensic Analysis: Windows and the Basic Cyber Investigations: Cellular Records Analysis courses. He is the sole developer of NW3C's PerpHound™, Photo Hunter, Report Generator, and Utility Suite tools. In addition, Justin is an instructor for most of NW3C's cybercrime courses including ADFA-Mac, ADFA-Mobile I, ADFA-Win, BCI-DF, BCI-DW/OSINT, and BCI-CRA. Justin was also the NW3C team-lead on the validation and update Microsoft's COFEE tool, versions 1.1.2 and 2.1. When Justin joined NW3C in December 2006, he served as a Cybercrime Specialist.

After earning a Bachelor of Science degree in Criminal Justice with an emphasis in Law Enforcement from Grand Valley State University, Justin spent five years as a Special Agent for US Army Counterintelligence. The last two years were spent as a Computer Forensic Examiner for the Cyber Counterintelligence Activity (CCA). CCA has worldwide jurisdiction and is the US Army's primary counterintelligence investigative agency in computer forensics. As a Special Agent for CCA, Justin conducted multi-agency investigations in security compromises, espionage, and terrorism.

Justin has taught classes in almost every state within the United States, as well as the territory of Puerto Rico; and has presented at conferences in the United States, Canada, and the Bahamas. Justin has over twenty years of experience building, fixing, and repairing computers and earned his A+ certification in September of 2006. Justin earned his Certified Cyber Crime Examiner (3CE) from NW3C in January of 2019.
