IADLEST Membership

We need your assistance in helping us schedule four-hour pursuit policy workshop training in your state. Our IADLEST grant, in partnership with ALERT (Association of Law Enforcement Emergency Response Trainers), is tasked with scheduling 150 workshops throughout the United States, and your help is needed.

We are asking that you help us by scheduling a four-hour workshop in major populated areas of your state, and help with marketing the training through your agency contact list. There is no cost to the hosting agency, as we will provide the instructors and lesson material, and there is no tuition to attend the training. We would ask that you schedule training through your academy, or have interested agencies contact us with dates they would be willing to host a training class. All training is held in a classroom and we would need a DVD player, LCD projector and screen.

These workshops could also be done at Chiefs, Sheriffs, or other Peace Officer conferences you may be doing, and if a workshop is done primarily for agency heads, we could gear the training specifically to them and shorten the time to accommodate their conference or meeting schedule.

As you know, this is one of the grants that IADLEST is tasked with, and your assistance is necessary for us to fulfill the grant requirements, and show NHTSA that IADLEST is capable of providing this training. If you can schedule one or more workshops in your state, we will also provide course announcements that can be tailored to the hosting agency. The purpose of the workshops is to reduce the number of deaths and injuries resulting from vehicle pursuits. The workshops address law enforcement vehicular pursuit policy issues, including factors to consider when initiating, conducting, and terminating a pursuit. Techniques discussed are consistent with the International Association of Chiefs of Police guidelines.
